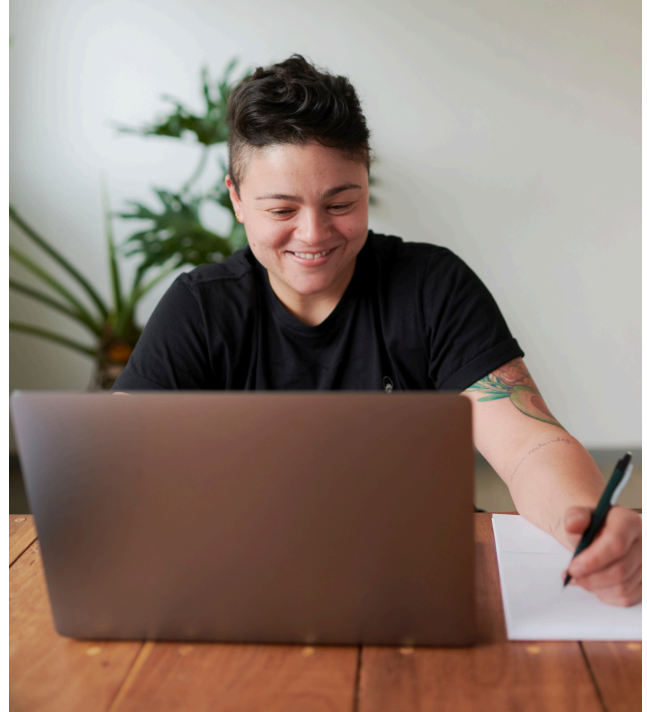
A network of individuals and family members using self-directed supports in Rhode Island
