Important Information About Early Intervention

- Early Intervention is a system of supports and services to help families meet the needs of their infant or toddler with a disability or developmental delay.
- The Early Intervention process includes an evaluation/assessment of all areas of development and a discussion of your concerns and priorities.
- We will want to know the things your child can already do and the things that are hard for them. Sharing what you know about your child will help us understand your child's strengths and needs.
- If your child is eligible, an Individualized Family Service Plan will be developed with you. We will have a detailed conversation in order to understand your daily activities and how your child's skills and behaviors impact their participation.

- Together we will develop goals based on what is most important to you to work on to help your child become successful in family and community activities.
- Children learn best when they practice new skills during everyday activities with family members and caregivers.
- Services usually take place in the home or where the child spends his/her day.
- EI Providers will show you and other caregivers, ways to work with your child to support his/her development and learning. They will coach you to use their therapies and strategies throughout your child's daily activities and routines.

- learn and use knowledge and skills
- take appropriate action to meet their needs

- know their rights
- communicate their child's needs
- help their child develop and learn
