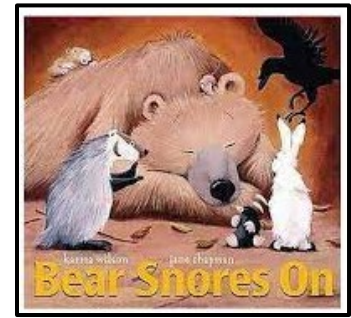






**Book Title: Bear Snores On**

Grade Level: PK-2

Brief Plot Synopsis: During the winter, Bear is hibernating. His friends use his cave to wait out a snow storm and eventually wake him up!



<b>Object to Be Used</b>	<b>What part/page of the story does it apply to?</b>	<b>What are possible learning objectives?</b> Visual skills, auditory skills, motor skills, communication skills, academic skills
Faux Fur 	Any time a new animal is introduced	<u>Motor:</u> Student can reach for/feel the faux fur, noting its texture.
Pillow 	When Bear is sleeping When Bear's friends fall asleep	<u>Motor:</u> Student can reach for/feel the pillow. Student can imitate the action of sleeping, putting their head on the pillow.
Tissue or "ACHOO" recorded on a switch 	When Bear sneezes and wakes up	<u>Motor:</u> Student can reach for/feel the tissue. Student can imitate the action of sneezing. Student can activate the switch at the appropriate time. <u>Auditory:</u> Student can listen to the sound of someone sneezing on the switch.
Balloon 	When Bear joins the party and tells stories	<u>Motor:</u> Student can reach for/feel the balloon. Student can hit the balloon or make it bounce. <u>Auditory:</u> Student can listen to the sound of the balloon being hit. <u>Visual:</u> Student can view the balloon on a contrasted background.

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
