Brief Plot Synopsis: A little girl and her mother work hard to save enough money for a

new chair for their home after all their furniture burned in a fire.



Object to Be Used	What part/page of the story does it apply to?	What are possible learning objectives? Visual skills, auditory skills, motor skills, communication skills, academic skills
Coins/money	When the little girl and her mother work to earn money for a new chair. When Grandma adds money to the jar and counts it. When the jar gets full.	Motor: Student can reach for/feel the money. Student can place money in a jar. Academic: Student can count how many coins they put into the jar, or, for older students they can use this opportunity to count the value of the money. Auditory: Student can listen to the money being dropped in the jar.
Handwarmer	When the girl talks about the fire that burned down her house.	Motor/Communication: Student can reach for/feel the hand warmer and comment on its temperature, things that are hot.
Pieces of flower fabric	When the girl talks about her mom wanting a new chair. When the girl and her mom go shopping for a new chair. When they bring home the new chair.	Motor/Communication: Student can reach for/feel the fabric, commenting on its textures and colors. Academic: Student can sort pieces of fabric by big, small, color, texture, etc.

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
