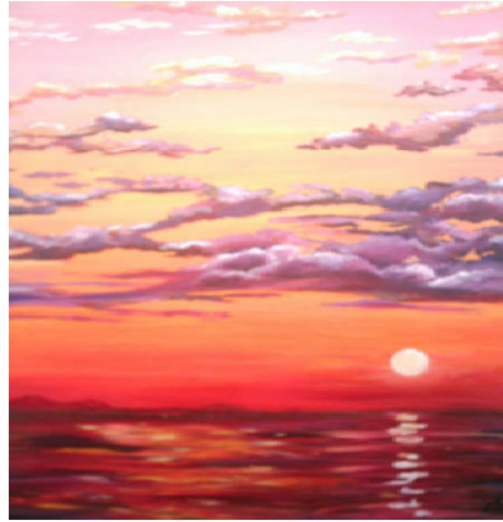


Clouds, Clouds, Clouds, and Clouds



What are clouds?



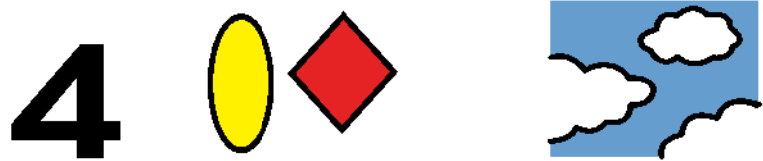
Clouds are little drops of water up in the sky.

They are so small and light they float in the sky.



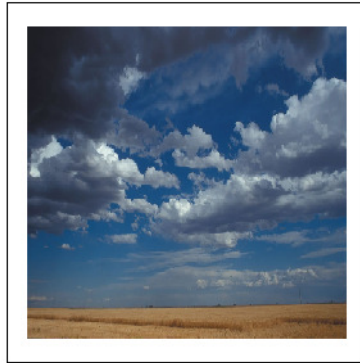
There are four types of clouds.



Cirrus



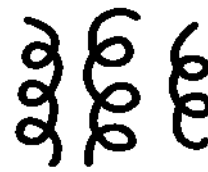
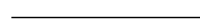
Stratus



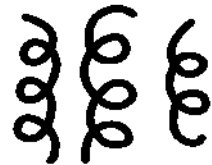
Cumulus



Nimbus



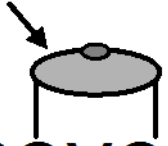
Cirrus clouds are thin and wispy.
