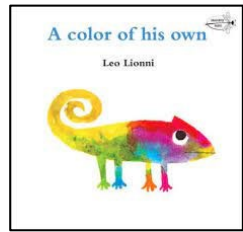




**Book Title: A Color of His Own**

Grade Level: PK-2

Brief Plot Synopsis: All animals have a color, except chameleons. Chameleons are all different colors and change depending on what they're next to!



<b>Object to Be Used</b>	<b>What part/page of the story does it apply to?</b>	<b>What are possible learning objectives?</b>
<p>Bright colored cut out chameleon against a black background</p> <p>OR color cards on a light box.</p>  	<p>Each time a new color is introduced and the chameleon changes colors.</p> <p>Red Yellow Green Pink Gray Stripes Polka dots</p>	<p><b>Visual skills, auditory skills, motor skills, communication skills, academic skills</b></p> <p><u>Motor:</u> Student can reach for/feel the colors and if able to select the correct one according to the page in the book.</p> <p><u>Academic/communication:</u> Every time the chameleon changes color, student can point to/find the correct color he turned in a choice of two. Student can verbally identify what color the chameleon changes to.</p> <p><u>Visual:</u> Student can view the colored chameleons on the black background or the different colors on the light box.</p>
