











"You do not want to miss the first day at your new school!"




















Mr. Hartwell tried to cheer up Sarah.



"You will meet new friends."

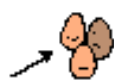


            
Sarah was afraid. Sarah did not know people at her new school.

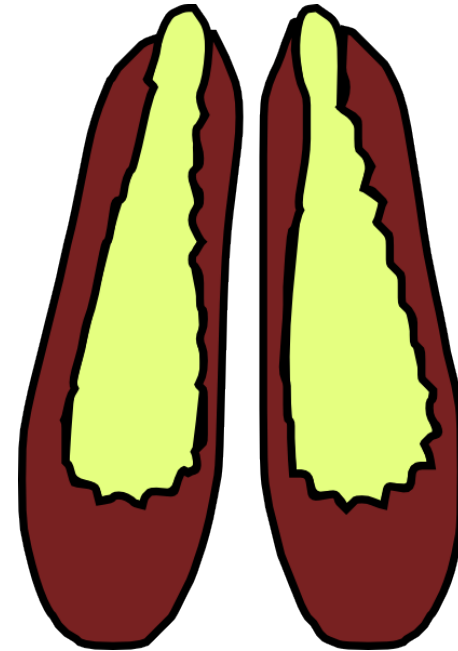
       
I will hate my new school.

Sarah was scared.





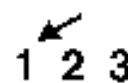
The principal, Mrs. Burton, walked to Sarah's car.



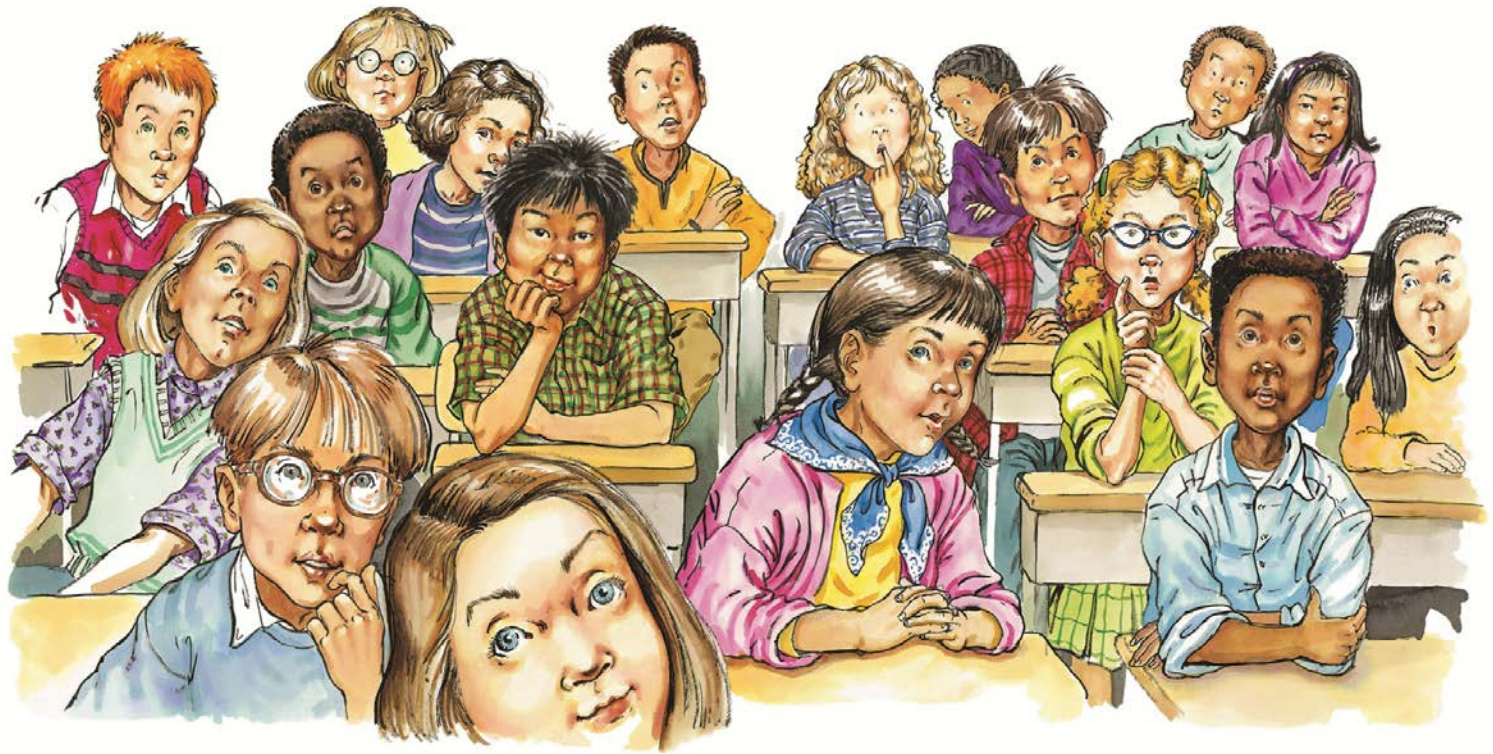
The principal said hello to Sarah and walked her into the school.

"Everyone is scared the first day."



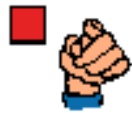
Sarah walked into the classroom.
