frindle". The teachers were mad. Many students had detention. Mrs. Granger
















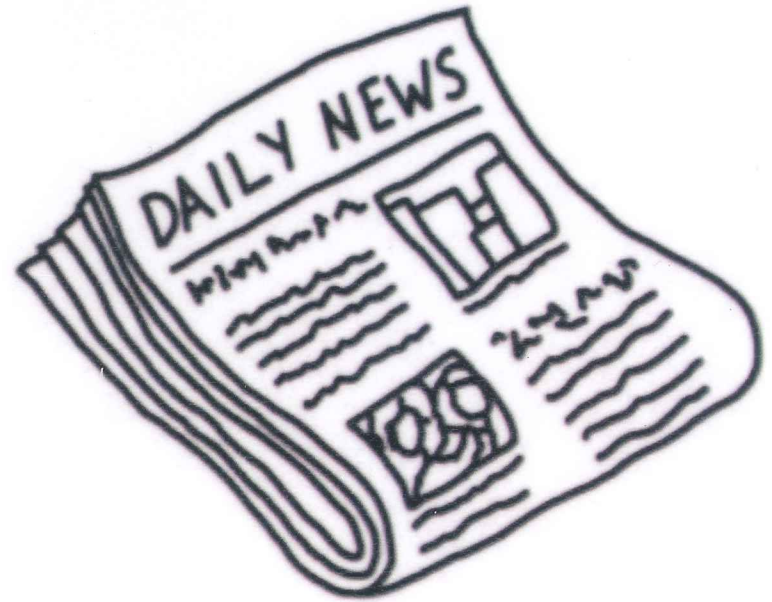
