


Frog ran to Toad's house.

Frog tells Toad to wake up. It is Spring.






Frog tells Toad the sun is out.


Toad is in his bed.

Toad pulls the covers over his head.
















Frog tells Toad he will miss all the fun.

Toad goes back into bed.






Frog tells Toad he will be lonely.

Frog looks at Toad's calendar.





Toad asks if this is true.















Frog tells Toad to look at his calendar.
