In this book there was a girl named Jane.

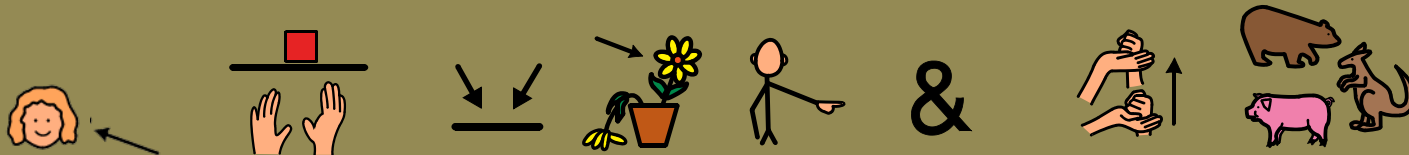

She wanted to live there and help animals.













