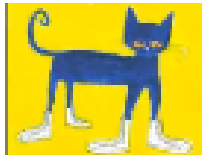

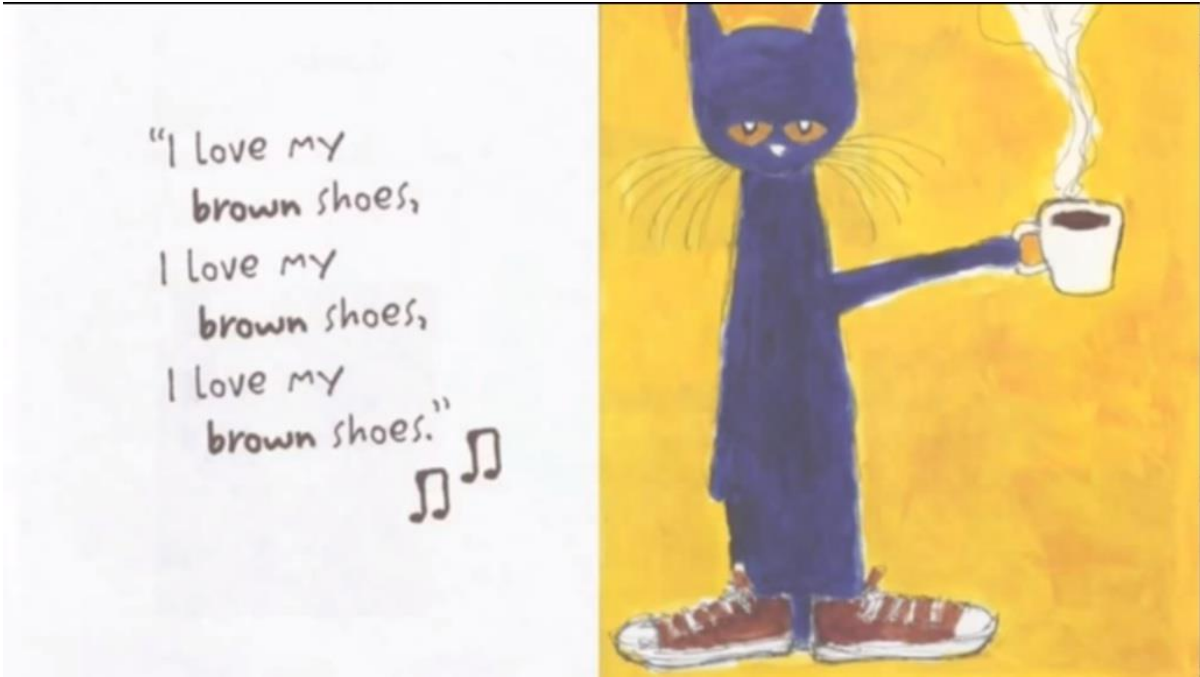


Pete the Cat stepped in mud.
