

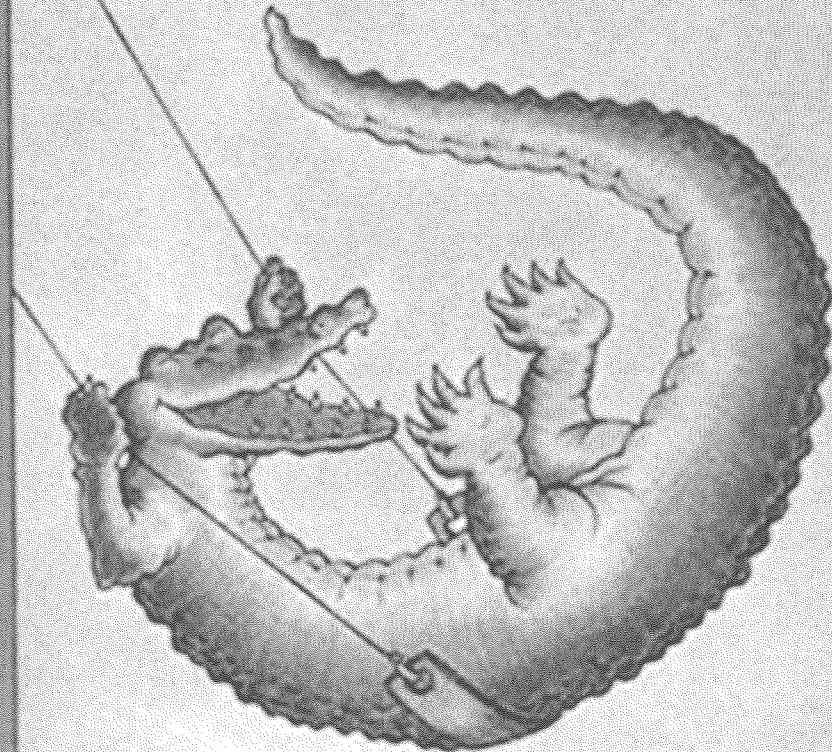

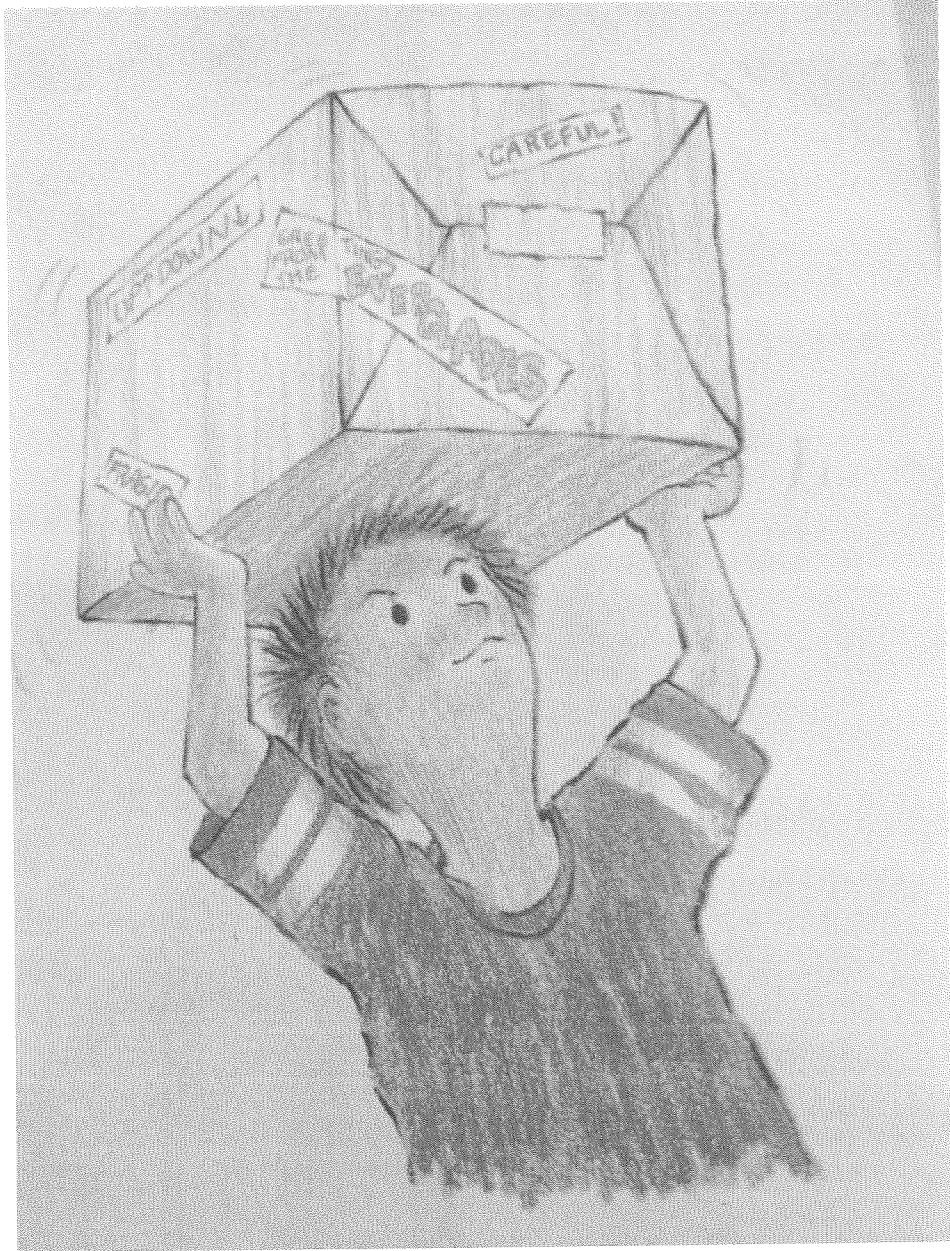

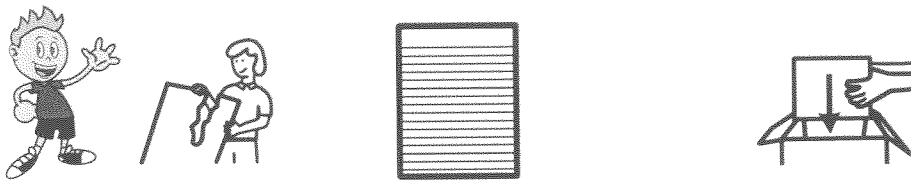


A big box came in the mail for Zack.

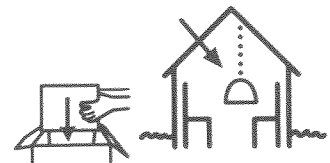


Zack shakes the box.

There is another box inside.

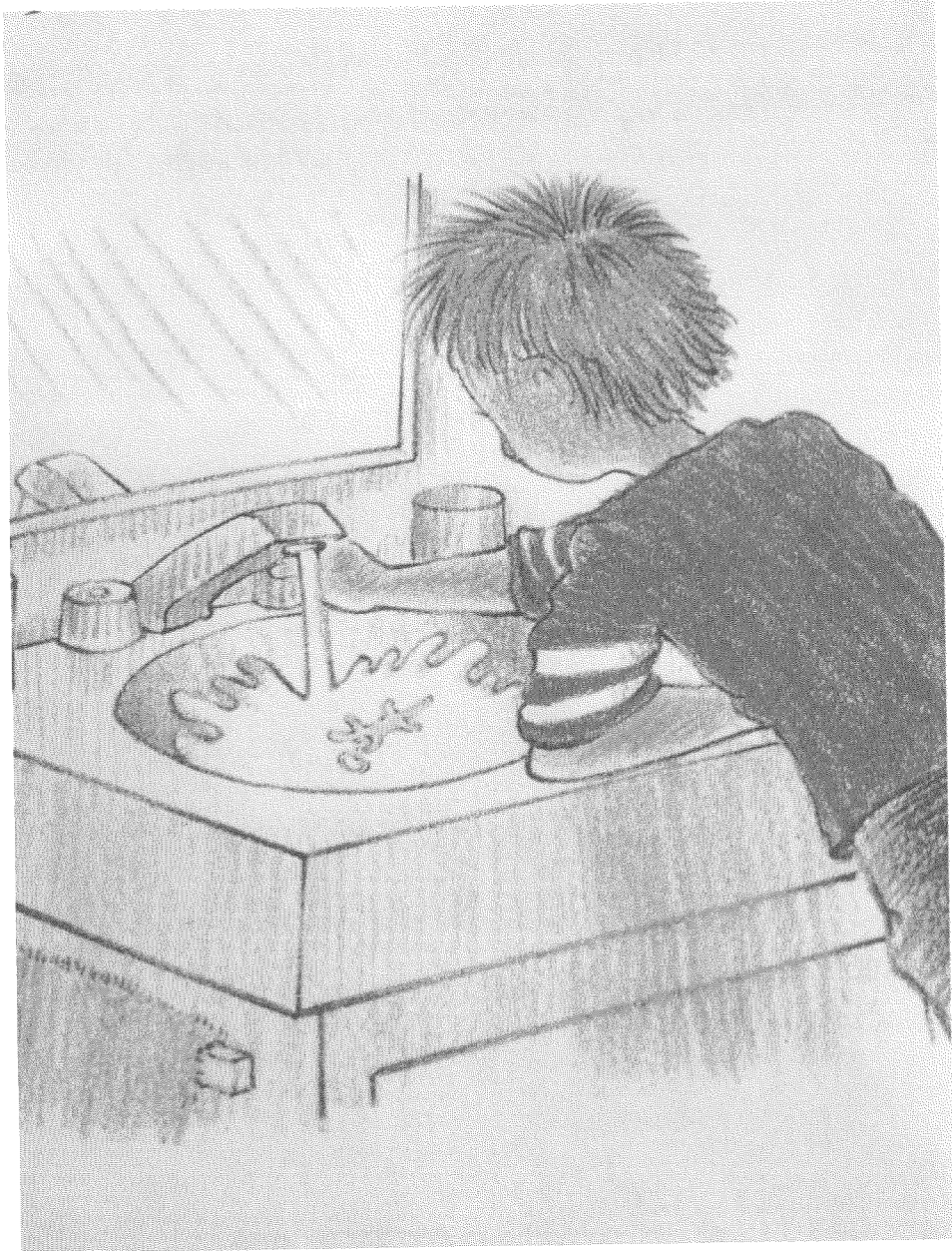


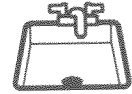
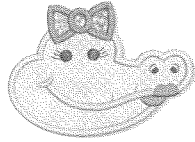


Zack lifts the lid.

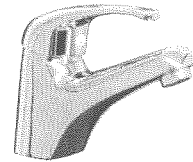
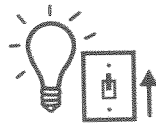


It is a sleeping alligator, Bridget.

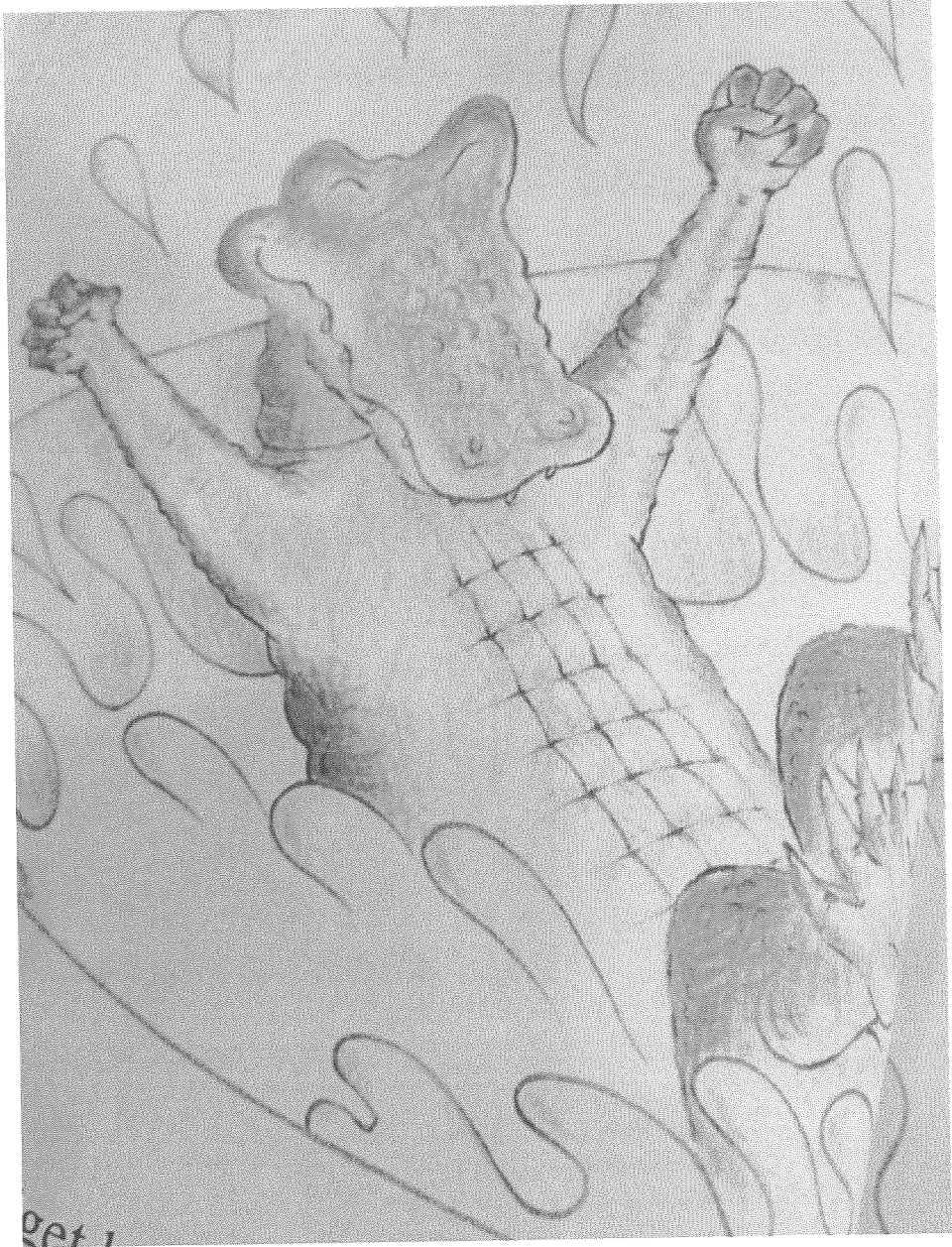


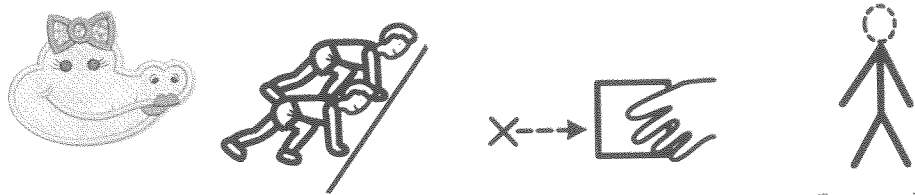


Zack puts Bridget the Alligator in the sink.

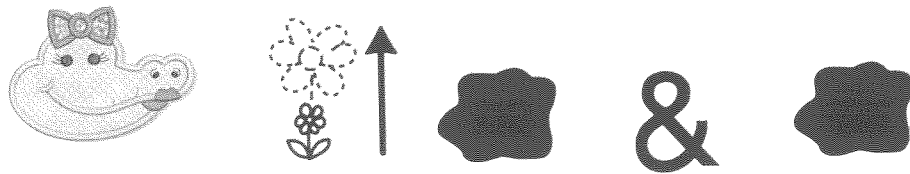


Zack turns on the faucet.

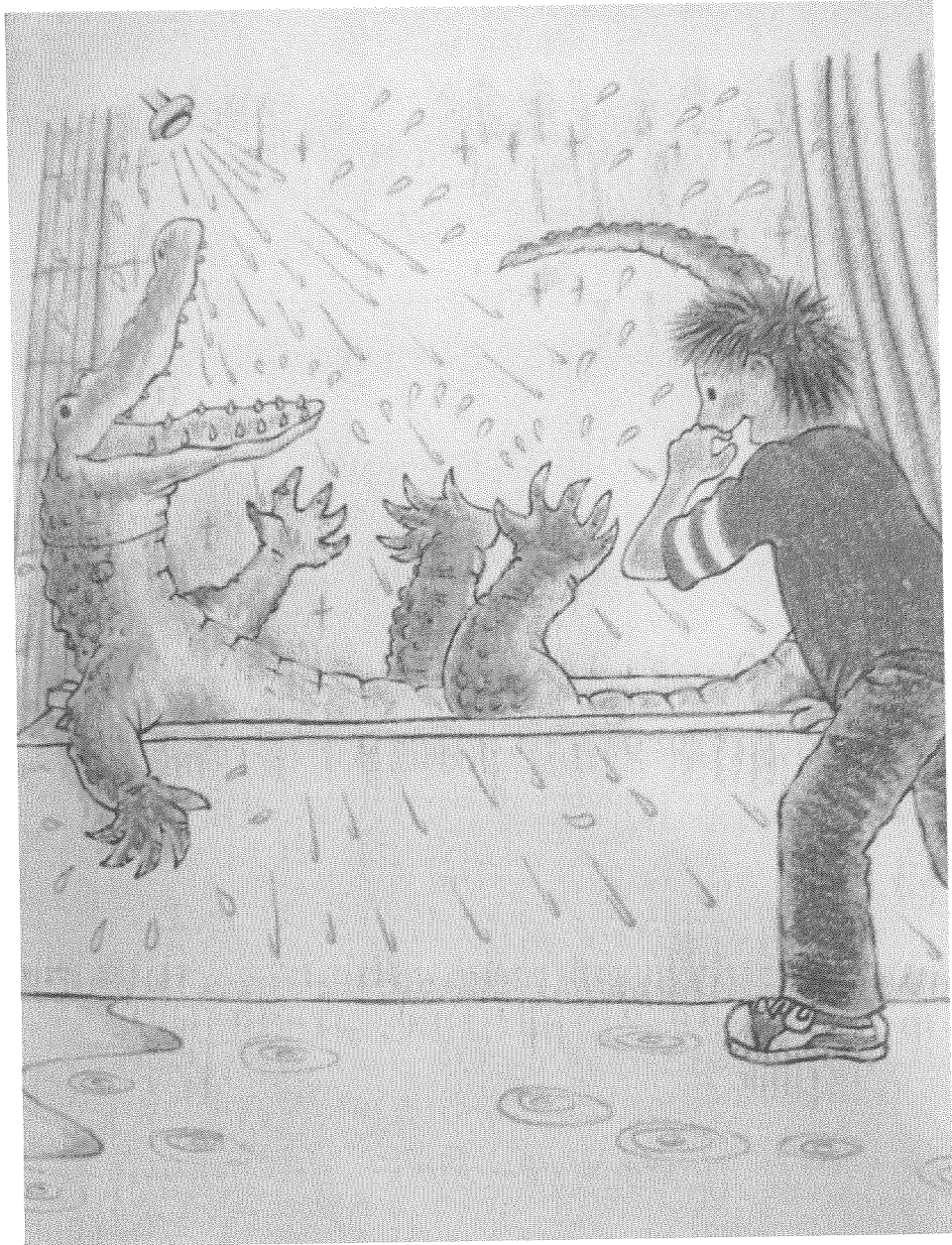


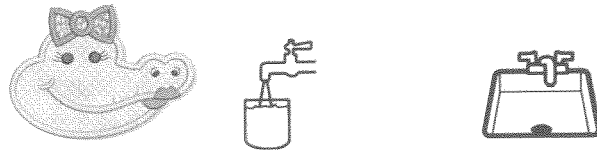


Bridget begins to move her body.

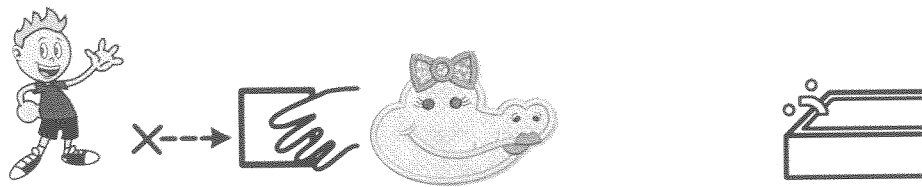


Bridget grows bigger and bigger.

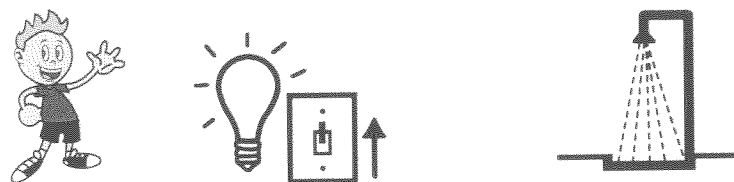




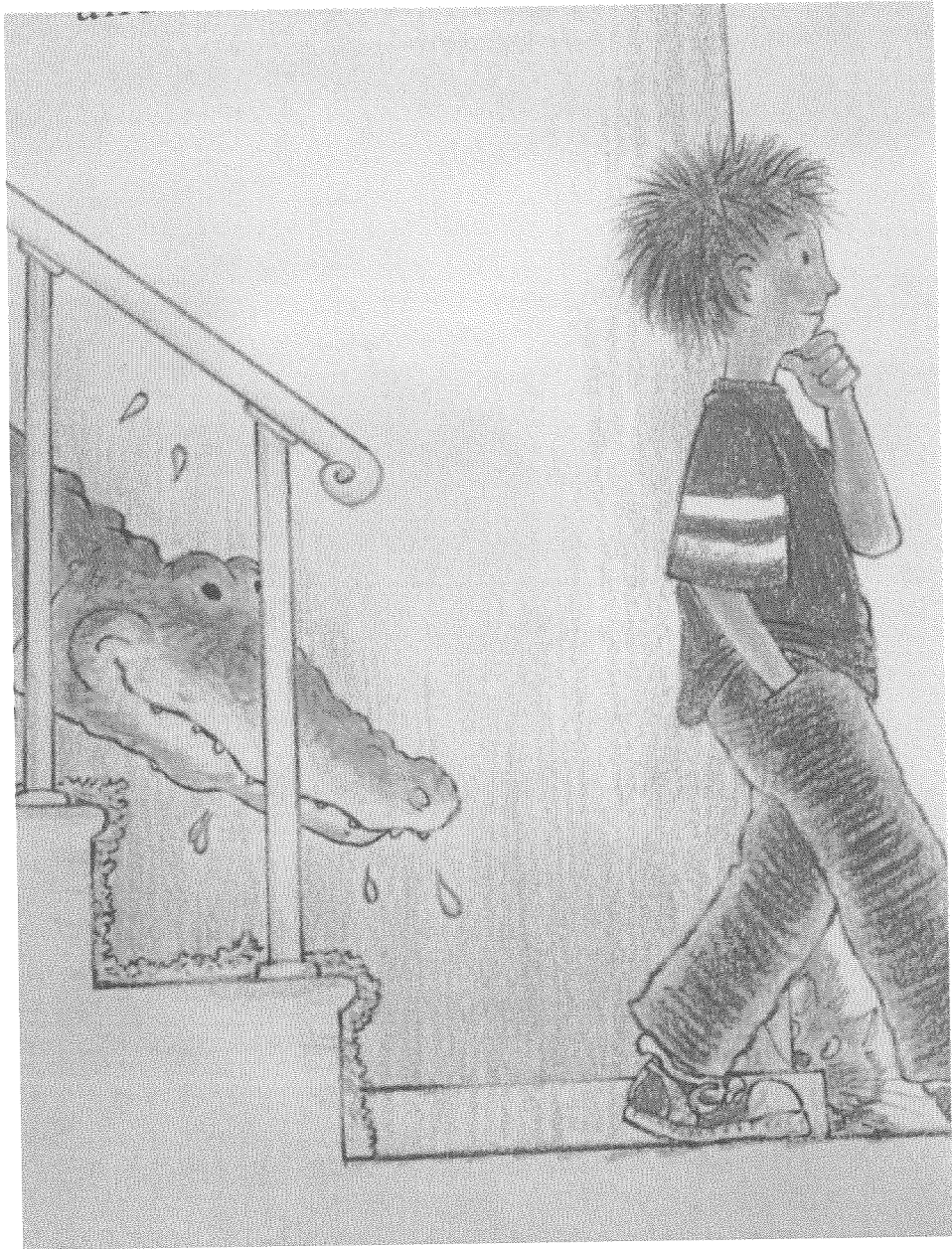
Soon, Bridget fills the sink.

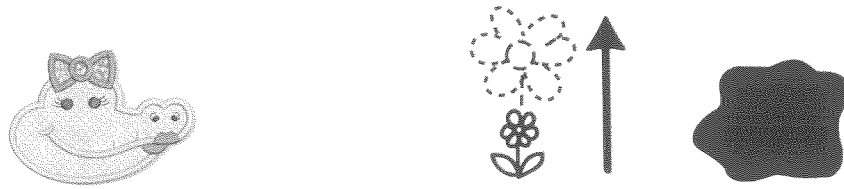


Zack moves Bridget to the tub.

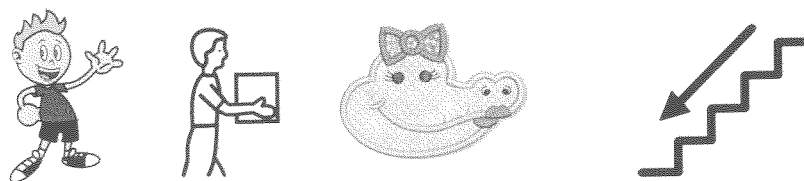


Zack turns on the shower.



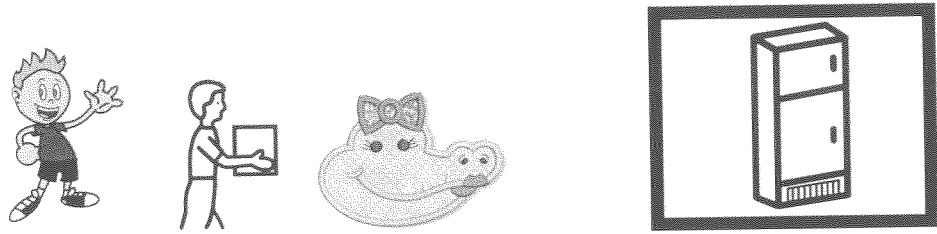


But Bridget keeps growing bigger.

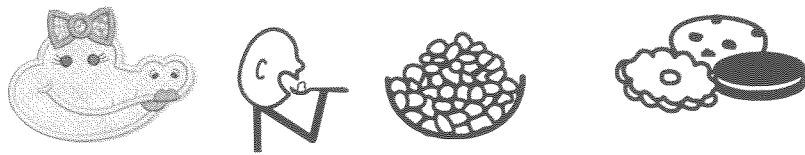


Zack takes Bridget downstairs.

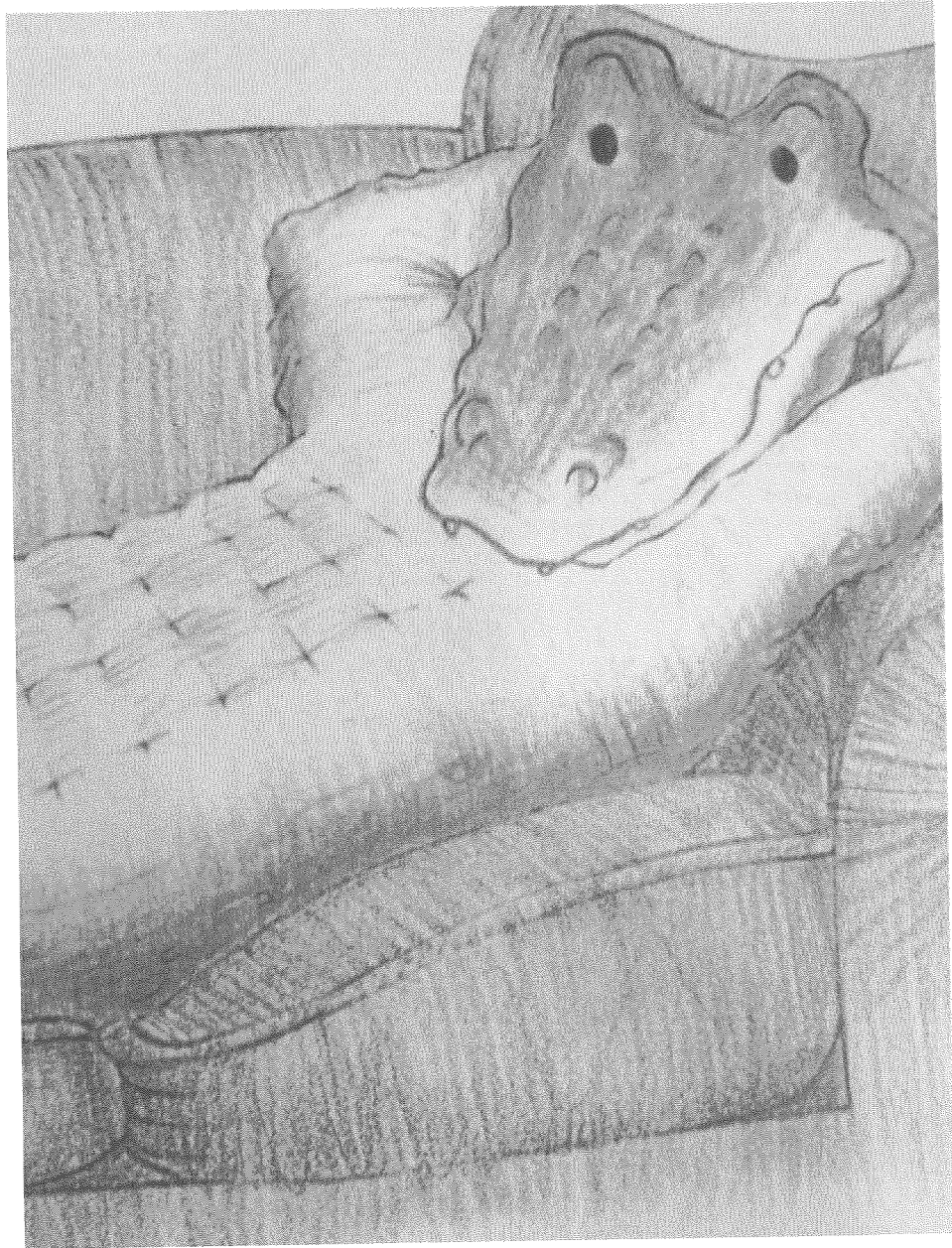




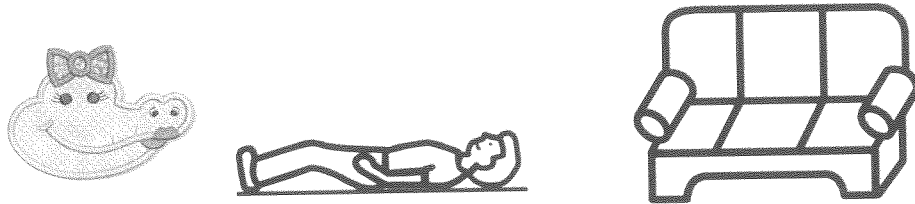
Then Zach takes Bridget to the kitchen.



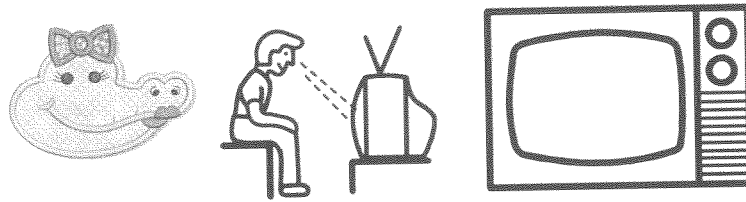
Bridget eats a lot of cookies.



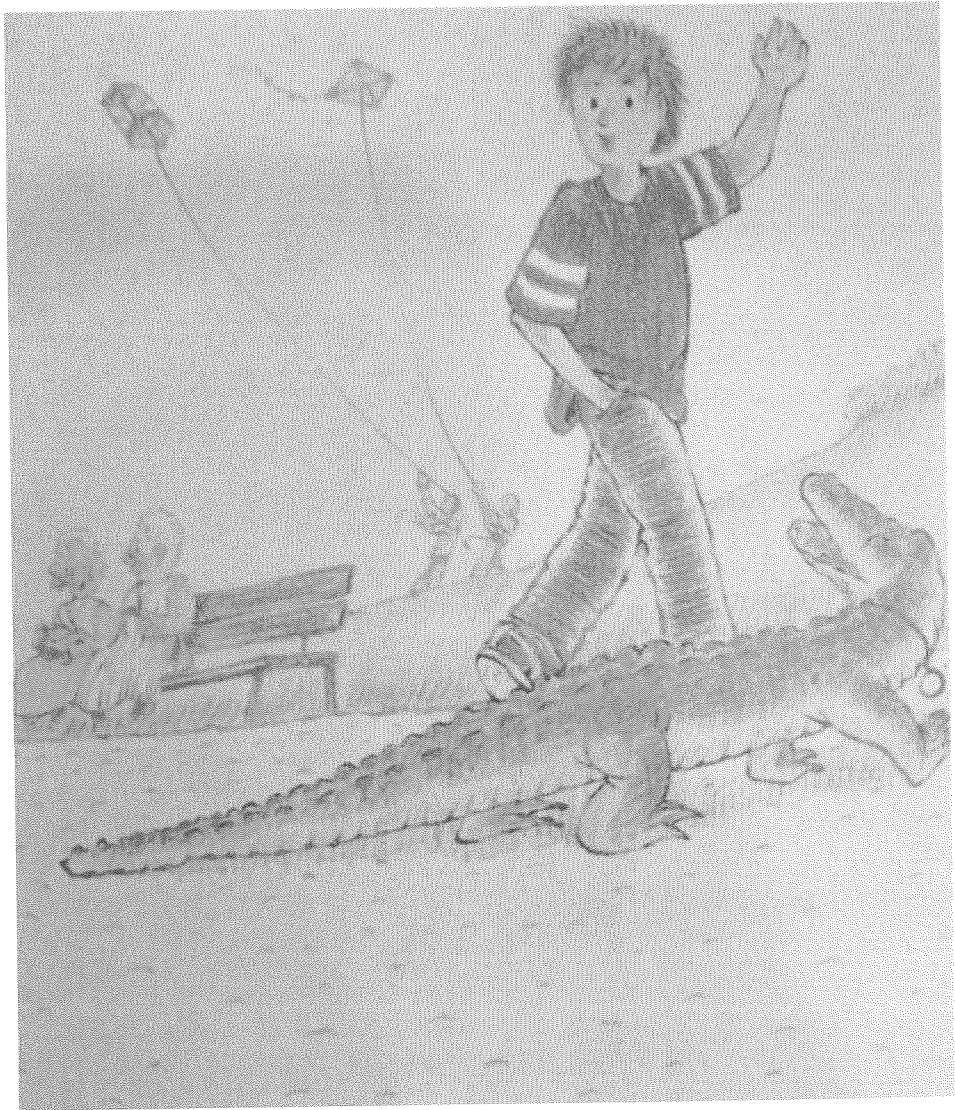

Zach takes Bridget for a walk in the park.

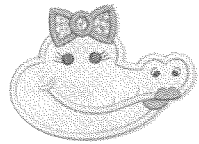

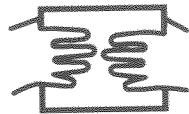


Bridget is starting to shrink.



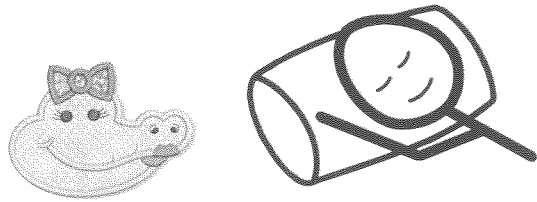


Bridget is now little again.
